Festival Rules & Procedures

- 1. Spaces will be awarded to the first 50 entrants. Rental spaces are 10' x 10'.
- **2.** All items for sale must be displayed within your allotted display area. If you need more space, you should consider purchasing a second space.
- **3. All items must be handmade** by the applicant and his/her associates. We want to promote the artists and their arts and crafts. Therefore, we will not accept commercial or service applications. Each vendor must present tangible items for sale.
- 4. **First time applicants** must supply photos or photo files in JPEG format or have a representative website with photos to be considered for the show.
- 5. Vendors are responsible for collecting and paying sales tax and should have (but are not required to have) a valid vendor's or transient vendor's license issued by the Ohio Sales Tax Department.
- 6. Set up will begin at 7:30 A.M. and will end at 9:30 A.M. Once unloaded, vendors must park in the designated parking area, then return to complete their set up. Each exhibitor is responsible for furnishing her/his own display, display walls, tables, chairs, etc.
- 7. The Fall Festival takes no percentage of vendor profits.
- 8. Each exhibitor is selected strictly on merit as interpreted by an independent jury.
- 9. Once a vendor is accepted for the show, there will be no refunds issued for cancellations.
- 10. *This is to be a family friendly event*. Any vendor displaying items deemed objectionable by the Festival Director will be asked to leave the Festival without refund.
- 11. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the Fairgrounds.
- 12. No food is to be sold on the Fairgrounds except by an approved vendor.
- 13. No raffles or solicitations are permitted on the Fairgrounds.
- 14. **Breakdown will begin no earlier than 4:00 P.M**. (unless approved by the Festival Director). Each vendor is responsible for disposing of his/her trash. There will be plenty of trash barrels. Please be respectful of others and of the Fairgrounds.
- 15. Any vendor and/or associates found to be defacing Fairgrounds property in any way will be asked to leave immediately with no refund and will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
