#### FIGHT SONG (Rules and Regulations):

- \*Traditional school fight song performed to recorded marching band music (CD, phone and plug in with backup CD)
- \*Teams will be announced, take the floor, with timing beginning with the first beat of the music or organized movement
- \*One minute and 30 seconds time limit
- \*Up to three CONSECUTIVE eight-counts may be incorporated with stunts, tumbling, and/or jumps.

#### GAME DAY ROUTINE (Rules and Regulations):

- a. Leading the Crowd!-The Game Day Routine showcases what cheerleading is all about. Teams will be evaluated on their ability to lead the crowd, proper game day skill incorporations/performance, motion/dance and overall routine.
- b. The performance will follow this order: Band Chant, Situational Sideline, Time Out Cheer, and Fight Song. Collectively the sideline and cheer section will be defined as the Crowd Leading portion of the routine. Time limit is three (3) minutes. Following completion of the band chant (which should have an emphasis on crowd appeal and practicality), the announcer will give squads a game scenario including an offense or defense situation. Teams should show their definitive understanding of the situation with an offensive or defensive crowd-leading response, then a time-out cheer, followed by transition into their fight song. No stunts or tumbling is permitted, however jumps and kicks will be allowed.
- c. The use of crowd leading tools such as signs, poms, flags and/or megaphones is required.
- d. The incorporation of skills (stunts and tumbling) are only allowed during fight song, sideline and cheer. Stunts and tumbling are not allowed as a transition before/between sections, this would include the team’s entry to the floor and any time prior to starting the performance.

It is OK to duplicate this form for additional entries.

## 2019 Ashland County Fair “We’re Here to Cheer”

### GENERAL RULES

1. All members of the cheerleading squad must be current members of the official school spirit squad and must attend the school they are representing.
2. All teams/individuals must be supervised during all official functions by a qualified supervisor/coach.
3. No jewelry is allowed of any kind including but not limited to: ear, nose, tongue, belly button, facial rings, bracelets, necklaces, rings or pins.
4. Shoes must be worn by all competitors.
4. Flags, banners, signs, poms, and megaphones are the only props permitted.
5. Participants are not permitted to tumble over, under, or through any stunt or prop.
6. The team and each participating member/coach should constantly display good sportsmanship throughout the entire performance in regards to respect for themselves, other teams, and the viewing audience of all ages. Teams should refrain from any taunting, bragging, or suggestive expressions or gestures, as well as discrimination of any nature.
7. Teams should take the floor immediately with spirit and enthusiasm, but without excessive gestures. All teams should refrain from any type of excessive celebration following the team’s performance.
8. There should not be any organized exits or other activities after the official ending of the routine.
9. To compete, proper liability forms must be completed by ALL team members, team registration forms completed by each coach and competition fees must be paid.
10. All teams must provide their own CD or phone and plug in with backup CD. Each team is required to have a responsible adult remain at the music station that knows the routine and music. This representative is responsible for starting the music and stopping the music in case of technical malfunction or injury.
11. Traditional game day uniform is required.
12. Competition floor for cheer teams is a foam cheer floor 54 x 42.
13. Ashland County Fair reserves the right to add, change, delete, or combine divisions for any reason.
